

Pool Risk Assessment – Lutanda Yarramundi 2017

Hazard	Risk	Prevention
Slipping while moving around the outside of the waters edge.	Low Risk	Follow signage. Keep pavement clean of dirt and leaf debris. Encouragement to avoid wet patches if at all possible
Tripping over obstacles or raised pavement	Low Risk	Keep chairs and towels away from waters edge. Pool toys (balls, noodles etc.) to stay in the water or packed up. Regular checks of pavement bricks.
Getting out of the pool	Low Risk	Encourage usage of handrail and steps provided
Drowning	Low Risk	Pool fence installed to Australian Standard. Adult supervision at all times with children under the age of 18. No swimming alone at any time
Infection	Low Risk	Pool tested and maintained via cleaning and chemicals on a regular basis – in accordance with local council requirements.
Diving in shallow end	Medium Risk	Follow Signage. Encouragement to check depth markers.
Unable to swim	Low Risk	Keep out of pool area unless directly supervised on a 1:1 ratio. Proper floatation device to be worn or used. Stay close to edge of shallow end of the pool.
